**Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

- (1) This licence permits only one (1) day of licensable activities each calendar year on the second or third weekend in September.
- (2) A suitably trained first aider or medical personnel must be present at the event at all times during licensable activities.
- (3) The licence holder shall produce and make available to all responsible authorities (as defined by the Council's Licensing Policy) at least 4 weeks prior to every event, an Event Management Plan, which specifies the date that licensable activities shall take place.
- (4) A minimum of 3 (three) SIA licensed door supervisors shall be in attendance and operational at the premises for the duration of all licensable activities.
