and the plans and particulars submitted in connection therewith and subject also to due compliance with the conditions specified hereunder:—

1. The development hereby permitted must be begun within a period of five years beginning with the date on which this permission is granted.
2. The development hereby permitted shall not be brought into use until the areas on the approved plan for car parking, loading and manoeuvring shall have been made available, surfaced and marked out and the area shall be retained and reserved for that purpose at all times.
3. The development hereby permitted shall not be brought into use before the new access to Hawley Lane shall have been constructed to the satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority.
4. Before the development commences a landscaping and tree planting scheme shall be submitted to and approved by the Local Planning Authority. Such scheme shall specify the position, species and size of the trees to be planted and the phasing and timing of such planting.

The reasons for the conditions above are:—

1. To comply with Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971.
2. & 3. In the interests of highway safety.
4. & 5. To ensure that the appearance of the development is satisfactory.
