DECISION AND THE REASON(S)

Address: 11 Chapel Street, Farnborough, GU14 8AH

Date of site visit: 10/08/22

Reasons: Consideration for addition to the BLI, following on from Conservation Area Review

Recommendation: The building is two storey, semi-detached, red brick, with a gable end stack. Partial first floor front elevation render, with ivy growth. Buff brick quoin detail, string course and window arches. Later lean-to front porch, with slate roof, brick work and glazed panels and door. Sliding sash windows to the front ground floor elevation and side hung casements to the first floor. Single storey rear, lean-to extension. Boundary fence and picket gates, with standard hedging to the north and east boundaries. The building first appears on the 1881 map, as an 'L' shaped building and outbuilding to the rear. The attached building to the south is labelled as a Methodist Chapel. The plot is not split, so it is assumed this may have been a residence associated with the Chapel. The building has been altered, with modern additions of windows, the porch and rear extensions to the original, as well as a render to the front first floor.
