In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Act the Council, as the local planning authority, hereby PERMIT erection of three stables at Easter Ross House, Minley Road, Cove

in accordance with your application received on 2nd June, 1982

as amended by


and the plans and particulars submitted in connection therewith and subject also to due compliance with the conditions specified hereunder:—

1. The development hereby permitted must be begun within a period of five years beginning with the date on which this permission is granted.
2. The stables shall be used only to accommodate the applicant's own horses and shall not be used for any commercial riding, breeding or training purposes.
3. A 2 metre high wooden fence, of a type to be agreed with the Local Planning Authority, shall be erected prior to the construction of the stables hereby approved, between the points marked XX on the approved plan and shall subsequently be maintained to their reasonable satisfaction.

The reasons for the conditions above are:—

1. To comply with Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.
2. To prevent the establishment of a commercial use within the curtilage of the dwelling house.
3. To ensure that the site is adequately enclosed in view of the proximity of the M.3 Motorway and in the interests of visual amenity.
