Receiving main phase Employment Support Allowance	£16.45

Gross income less than £154.00 per week	£16.45
Gross income £154.00 to £223.99 per week	£37.80
Gross income £224.00 to £291.99 per week	£51.85
Gross income £292.00 to £388.99 per week	£84.85
Gross income £389.00 to £438.99 per week	£96.60
Gross income £484.00 and above per week	£106.05
