

Rushmoor Borough Council Workforce Profile -2023

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Introduction

Under the Equality Act 2010 local authorities must publish information relating to the make-up of the overall workforce with respect of their characteristics (e.g. age, sex and race) in comparison of the local population. Data for the local population is from the 2021 Census. Further data about the local population of Rushmoor can be found in on our Facts and Figures web page.

As of 31st March 2023 Rushmoor Borough Council employed 256 staff. Of these, 183 were employed full time and 73 were employed part time. This profile compares Rushmoor Borough Councils workforce with the age, sex, ethnic group and religion of Rushmoor residents.

It should be noted that the only time Rushmoor Borough Council captures its workforce's sex, age, religion and ethnic group when staff start employment. Age is calculated by date of birth, however unless staff updates HR with any changes, the workforce data relies on information supplied by staff when they start employment.

Sex

Rushmoor Borough Council's workforce is 63.3% female which is different to the population of Rushmoor which is 49.9% female. There is also a difference between the Rushmoor Borough Council's full-time and part-time workers, with more female part-time (93.2 %) compared to female full-time workers (51.4 %).

Age

Rushmoor Borough Council's has a higher percentage of their workforce over the age of 50 43.3 %, than the population of Rushmoor aged over 50 , which is 32.4%. This is however the opposite in terms of the younger population, with 6.6% of Rushmoor Borough Council's workforce being under 30, compared with 24.7% of the population of Rushmoor.

Religion

The largest religious group within Rushmoor Borough Council's workforce (40.6%) is Christianity however, this is only slightly below the local population amount (42.3%). As well as this, 25.8% of Rushmoor's full-time and part-time staff have not yet stated their religion or belief and therefore these findings may not be fully representative of Rushmoor's workforce.

Ethnic group

There appear to be minor differences in a small number of categories between Rushmoor's workforce population figures for 2023 and the 2021 census figures. The introduction of the Asian or British Asian: Nepali grouping is new and as a result we do not have Rushmoor data to compare against. However, 17.6% of Rushmoor's workforce did not provide information about their ethnic group which could affect the overall accuracy of some of these findings.
