Decision Taken: To formally sign off RIBA stage 2 designs for the new Farnborough Leisure Centre

DECISION AND THE REASON(S) FOR IT

To formally sign off the RIBA Stage 2 report relating to the new Farnborough Leisure Centre proposals with reference Cabinet report REG2501.

On the 11th February 2025, Cabinet approval (REG2501) was given to appoint Alliance Leisure Service Limited (ALS) as a Development Partner to progress design development for the new Farnborough Leisure Centre to the end of RIBA 3 and formal submission of a planning application.

The initial stages of the design process, RIBA 2 (concept design) are now concluded enabling a detailed design to progress through RIBA 3.

ALS has submitted their RIBA 2 report for review and formal sign off by the client (the Council). Sign off is required in order to proceed with the next phase of design in accordance with the delivery programme as set out in the Cabinet report.

In providing sign off, the Council notes a likely reduced floor area aligned to the emerging Hangar design concept, taking into consideration both site and budget constraints alongside leisure operator feedback following initial engagement.
