Summary – According to the 2021 mid-year population estimate, Rushmoor has a population of 100,100.

## Mid-year population estimates

The 2021 mid-year population estimate for Rushmoor from the Office for National Statistics (ONS) is 100,100. The mid-year population figure is data at a local authority area level, for smaller areas such as towns and wards there is data from the 2021 Census.

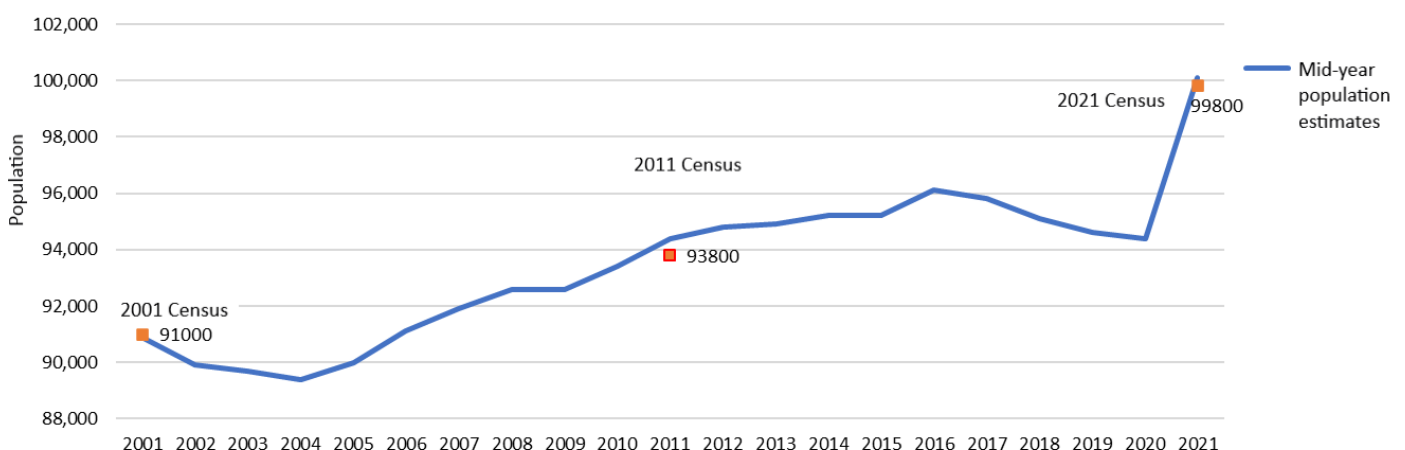

## Census and mid-year population estimates

The population of Rushmoor in the 2021 Census was 99,800, the 2021 mid-year population estimates has taken account of the Census population and there is a slight increase on the Census figure to 100,100.

The 2020 mid-year population estimate was 94,400 so there is a large rise in the population estimate to the 2021 figure. In spring 2023, the 2012 to 2020 population estimates will be revised by the ONS.

According to the 2021 mid-year population estimates, most local authority areas have more females than males but in Rushmoor 49.9% of the population are female and 50.1% of the population are male.

## Population density

The 2021 mid-year population estimate shows the population density of Rushmoor to be 2,563 people per sq. km. This is an increase from 2,417 people per sq. km in 2011. As Rushmoor is a largely urban area this high population density is to be expected. The population density of Hampshire 382 people per sq. km, the South East was 487 people per sq. km and in England was 431 people per sq. km in 2021.
