Survey Analysis: New Farnborough Leisure Centre

Proposed Facilities

The public's feedback shows strong positive alignment with the core facilities being proposed. As a "select all that apply" question, the counts below represent the total number of respondents who are looking forward to using each facility.

- Swimming Pools: 436 respondents.
- Café: 178 respondents.
- Fitness suite: 125 respondents.
- Soft play: 76 respondents.
- Exercise studio: 80 respondents.
- Spin studio: 46 respondents.

The high level of interest in the swimming pools, cafe, and fitness suite confirms that these provisions are meeting the core needs and desires of the public.

Importance of Outdoor Spaces

The importance of outdoor spaces was clear in the feedback.

- Planting / trees / biodiversity: 82.42% rated this as "Important."
- Spaces to sit / benches: 67.78% rated this as "Important."
- Outdoor café space: 48.24% of respondents rated this as "Important," and 34.31% were "Neutral."
- Skatepark: Opinions were evenly split. 35.57% thought this was important, 33.79% "Not important" and 30.63% were "Neutral"

This shows clear support for green spaces and seating, but mixed opinions on more specific amenities like a skatepark.

External Building Design

- 61.85% had a neutral opinion of the design.
- **13.87%** provided a **positive** rating (8 or above).
- 24.28% expressed a negative sentiment (rating of 1-4).
- → 75.72% of respondents had a **neutral or positive** opinion of the proposed leisure centre design.

Key Themes from Accessibility Comments

Positive Themes:

- Many respondents acknowledged that considering accessibility is a positive and crucial step.
- Some comments expressed support for proposed features like lifts, ramps, and good lighting.

Improvement Themes:

- The need for improved access for disabled individuals was highlighted, specifically mentioning requirements for ramps, wider doors, lifts, and adequate space.
- · There were concerns about the practicality of parking and drop-off areas for those with mobility issues.
- There were also requests for specific features, such as gender-separated showers, familyfriendly changing rooms, and prayer facilities.
- Suggestions for general improvements included I clear signage, good lighting, and wide, unobstructed corridors.

Impact on Town Centre Footfall

- For Local shops, 20.40% of respondents anticipated using them more while 62.38% were
- For Local cafés and restaurants, 19.88% of respondents said they would use them more, and 62.43% were neutral

Open Answers - Key Themes

Some of the major themes that were touched on include:

- Respondents were happy that a new leisure centre was being built, as it was identified as a priority facility for the community.
- Comments were also made in support of the new facilities that were proposed including the pool and the café.
- A number of respondents expressed disappointment about the absence of a sports hall to replace the one that was demolished.
- There were concerns the proposed leisure centre was too small to serve the community's needs, especially given the new housing developments in the area.
- There were also concerns about the adequacy of parking for the new centre
- Some comments described the design as too industrial or boxy.

Summary

There is broad support for the concept of a new leisure centre and its key facilities (pools, gym) although some concerns around the building's aesthetic, its size, and the lack of a sports hall. The comments reflect a strong desire for the centre to be a dynamic, community-oriented hub rather than simply a new building.

Q1 On a scale of 1-10, how much do you like the external building design as shown? (for example, appearance/materials)






Q3 How are you most likely to get to the new centre? (select all that apply)







Q4 What would encourage you to walk, cycle or use public transport to go the centre? (select all that apply)









Q10 What is your ethnicity?




