1. Identity of the Data Controller and contact details

2. What we need your information for and the legal basis for it

We need your personal information to process your fit and proper person application under The Mobile Homes (Requirement for Managers of Site to be Fit and Proper Person) (England) Regulations 2020 ("the Regulations"). The law allows us to use your personal information in this way to carry out our responsibilities under these Regulations as one of the Council's public tasks. In accordance with the Regulations, we are also required to establish and maintain a public register with details of persons who we are satisfied are fit and proper persons to manage a relevant protected site.

3. <u>Use for any other purposes</u>

If we need to use your information for any other purpose, we will normally inform you before using it, unless we believe you know about the new purpose already or there are legal reasons that prevent us from telling you.

4. Will you pass my information to anyone else?

We may share your information with other teams within the Council such as Planning and Housing Services in order to carry out our public tasks and to keep our records up to date. If you ask a Councillor for help we may pass information to them and other services to enable them to help you. We may also pass information about you to third parties where permitted or required by law to do so. This may include (but is not limited to) other local authorities and government departments or agencies carrying out their public tasks, such as the relevant Primary Care Trust, Health Protection Agency, the sewerage undertaker, the Health and Safety Executive, and the Fire Authority, HMRC and the Police in carrying out criminal investigations.

5. How we will store and look after your information

Your data will be held electronically and will not be stored in a country outside the UK. All paper records containing your personal information will be held securely in our filing systems and archives.

6. How long we will retain your information

We will keep your information on our records for a period determined within our retention guidelines, or as long as we are required to do so by law, or in accordance with our operational requirements. For information on our policy for retaining personal information please see our retention guidelines as published on Rushmoor Borough Council's website. We need your personal information, some of which may be sensitive, to support the processing of your application. It is necessary for us to process this information to determine your application appropriately as this is in the public interest.
