

## RUSHMOOR BOROUGH COUNCIL

Farnborough International Airshow  
(Taxi Hire at Separate Fares) Scheme 2022  
18 July 2022 – 22 July 2022 (inclusive)

The Council proposes to make a scheme to enable hackney carriages to carry passengers at separate fares during the Airshow.

1. The maximum number of licensed passengers can be carried per vehicle, paying £5 each, may travel:

FROM	TO	HOURS OF OPERATION
Farnborough Main Station ( <i>Hackney Carriage Stand</i> )	RAE Road Farnborough ( <i>Temporary Hackney Carriage Stand</i> )*	Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 8.00 pm only
RAE Road Farnborough ( <i>Temporary Hackney Carriage Stand</i> )*	Farnborough Main Station ( <i>Hackney Carriage Stand</i> )	Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 8.00 pm only

\*The location of the temporary stands will be identified on a map.

2. A child under the age of 3 who does not occupy a seat shall not be regarded as a fare paying passenger.
3. As in all taxis, special child restraints will not have to be provided but seat belts must be worn where appropriate.
4. No additional charge shall be made for the carriage of luggage.
5. The normal tariff for exclusive hire and/or where the journey is outside the shared hire area, is shown on the second fare table displayed in the vehicle.
