The Rushmoor Plan: Development Affecting Public Houses Supplementary Planning Document

Statement of Adoption

Regulation 11 and 14 Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England)
Regulations 2012

As part of the Rushmoor Plan, Rushmoor Borough Council has produced a Supplementary Planning Document relating to development affecting public houses in the Borough.


A report went to Cabinet on 2 June 2015 and the Cabinet resolved that the document should be adopted.

That resolution will come into force once the period for it to be 'called in' for scrutiny has passed.

The SPD is to be adopted on 30 June 2015.

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the supplementary planning document may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date on which the Supplementary Planning Document was adopted.
