- we need more information to make a decision on your claim, and what that information is.

#### We will not give your landlord any information about:

- your personal or household circumstances; or
- your financial circumstances.

You can withdraw your permission at any time.

It will not affect your claim if you do not give us permission to discuss your claim with your landlord.
